



## All-expense scholarships to a Weekend with Butterflies

Each year the Washington Butterfly Association offers three Idie Ulsh Young Naturalist Scholarships to our annual Weekend with Butterflies. Each scholarship covers registration, lodging for two nights, three meals, and round-trip mileage from home to the venue for a 10- to 17-year-old nature enthusiast and an accompanying parent or guardian. It's a chance to enjoy butterflies with people who know and love them. This year the Weekend is July 13 – 15, 2018, with headquarters at the White Salmon Grange (across the Columbia River from Hood River, OR) with field trips into good butterfly habitats in the area. Saturday we have an all-day field trip, then a banquet in the evening with an illustrated talk related to butterflies.
