Each scholarship covers registration fees, lodging for two nights, meals, and round-trip mileage from home to the venue for a 10-17 year old nature enthusiast and an accompanying parent or guardian. It is a chance to enjoy butterflies with people who know and love them. This year the Study Weekend will be June 28 – 30th, 2019, in the vicinity of Colville, WA.

Our Butterfly Study Weekend provides an opportunity to spend a day and a half on summer field trips that are often too far away for a one-day visit. Study areas usually are east of the Cascades. We gather on Friday evening for light refreshments, socializing and a review of species that we are likely to see on our field trips. Sunday we have a half-day field trip, ending in the early afternoon, giving people time to return home.
